Mhat is this project about?

The **DE&I Truth and Accountability Project** is a national effort to expose the gap between corporate diversity, equity, and inclusion (DE&I) promises and the reality of inaction, performative allyship, and systemic failures. We collect testimonies from employees to: V Document patterns of obstruction, sabotage, and legal non-compliance. V Push for real accountability—not just empty statements. V Advocate for stronger enforcement of DE&I commitments.

Why should I participate?

Your story matters. Many companies publicly pledge DE&I values but ignore complaints, retaliate against whistleblowers, or tokenize marginalized employees. By sharing your experience, you: • Expose systemic failures that others may also face. • Support advocacy for stronger workplace protections. • Empower others to speak up without fear.

Will my identity be protected?

Yes. You can:

- Submit without fear of disclosure of PII (identifiable details will be removed - however, information provided will be vetted to ensure credibility).
- Share **on the record** (if comfortable, with legal safeguards).
- Choose **confidential interviews** (handled by our legal team).

We follow strict privacy protocols to protect participants.

How can I share my story?

You have options:

- Written testimony (via secure online form).
- No Public Disclosure interviews (voice/video).
- **Tideo submission** (after vetting to ensure credibility, participant's face blurred/voice altered if needed).

We take legal precautions to shield participants. However, if you're concerned:
